Heat Abatement - Moving forward with the following measures

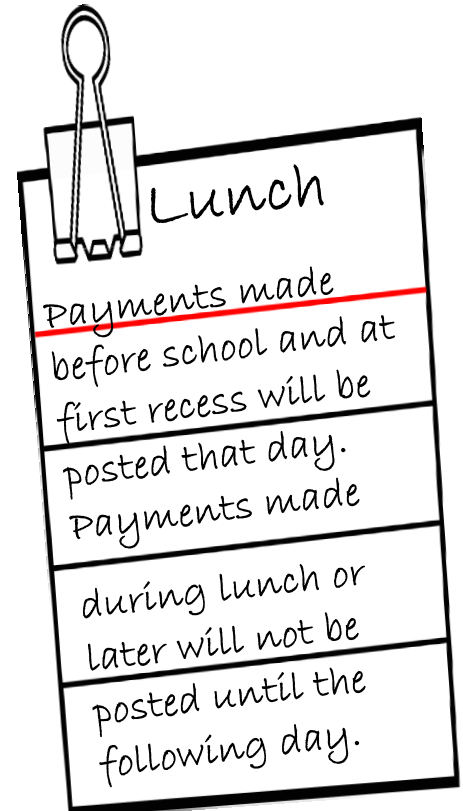
We want to emphasize the importance of hydration. We recommend your child bring a water bottle to school every day. Chilled water fountains are on the 2nd floor. There are 40oz insulated Ilima flasks for sale for \$25. We will be doing night time flushing (allowing cool air to enter) of classrooms without A/C. Portable A/C units will be left on overnight to help with cooling. We have dri-fit uniform shirts available as well as cotton. We have rooms available for classroom relocation if needed.

A Note on Pedestrian Safety

You may already experience that the traffic around campus is heavily congested before and after school. We want to remind all students and parents to exercise caution when crossing roadways to and from school and as an added precaution, please reinforce with your child the following safety measures:

For pedestrians

- Always cross within marked crosswalks or at street corners.
- Yield to approaching vehicles while crossing even if you have the right of way.
- Look left, right, and then left again before stepping into traffic.
- Make eye contact with drivers to ensure that they see you
- Obey all traffic signals
- If large vehicles are blocking your view, wait for them to pass before crossing.
- Never forget to look left, right, then left again before stepping into traffic.

For drivers

- Stay focused and alert for pedestrians.
- Look out for pedestrians who may be hidden from your view by other vehicles
- Be extra vigilant for pedestrians at dawn or dusk.
- Obey speed limits and never drive under the influence.
- Stop for a pedestrian in a crosswalk.

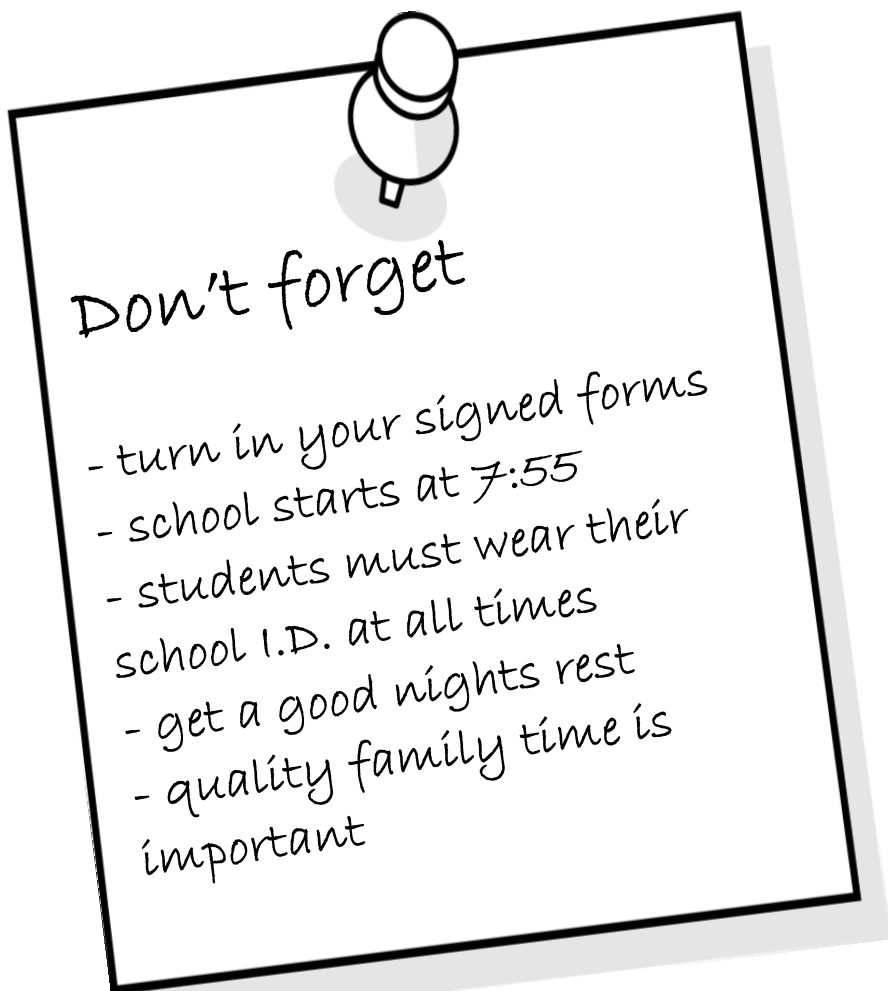
Jupiter Ed is your one stop on-line connection to:
